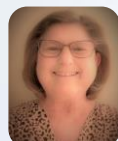

Dr. Eun-Ok Im is the Edith Folsom Honeycutt Endowed Chair and the Senior Associate Dean for Research and Innovation at Emory University, Nell Hodgson Woodruff School of Nursing. Dr. Im is an internationally known scholar and researcher in the field of global cross-cultural women's health research, addressing gender and ethnic disparities in health/illness experience of midlife women. Dr. Im is also internationally well-known as the founder of Situation Specific Theory, a major type of nursing theories that could connect nursing research to precision health.
